in its investment activities, mergers
and acquisitions, asset management, property
and country risk control, corporate governance
and investor protection.

Igor Gundobin was a member of the Board of Directors of SUN's portfolio companies and its private equity fund SUN Capital Partners, including JSC Klyuchevskoe, its Russian gold mining subsidiary SUN Gold Mining, and JSC Yubileinoe (Kazakhstan).

With over 25 years of business development and corporate and government interactions, Professor Gudobin now works on various investment and business development projects in Russia, India and Africa and regularly lectures at the SKOLKOVO School of Management and elsewhere on geographical, cultural and ethnic nuances in doing business, as well as economic ties between Russia and India and the prospects for the Asia-Pacific region in business associations in Russia and abroad.
